She became involved in Gerodontology during several years which she spent at the London Hospital Medical College, London, UK. Frauke Müller is active in several national and international professional Associations and currently President of the Swiss Dental Society for Elderly and Handicapped Persons (SGZBB). She is Associate Editor of *Gerodontology* and the textbook “Oral Healthcare and The Frail Elder”. Besides complete and implant prosthodontics her current interests focus on impairment in oral function following tooth loss and its correlation to cognitive impairment, nutritional state and mortality. She further started to develop an innovative tooth brush for elderly dependent persons to help preventing oral infections and aspiration pneumonia.
